CONCRETE NZ SPONSORSHIP AGREEMENT

TERMS & CONDITIONS

Concrete NZ [hereinafter referred to as the 'Organiser'] will display, promote and associate with the name and logo of the sponsor and their role in the event in all the places and circumstances in which the Organiser promotes the Concrete Construction Awards where it is reasonable to do so. In particular, the name of the sponsor will be indicated on the event communication material including: advertising, website, invitations, brochures, press releases, event documentation and visual materials, where space permits. Where space is limited the larger sponsors get priority.

PAYMENT

All prices are quoted in New Zealand dollars and are exclusive of GST. A 50% deposit is due on booking, the remaining 50% payment is due no later than 25 April 2025. The Organiser reserves the right to cancel and/or reallocate sponsorship if payment is not made in full by the allotted date. In such an event no refund of the deposit will be made.

ALLOCATION OF MATERIALS

Sponsors will be sent copies of the *Concrete Construction Awards* promotional material which can be distributed at their discretion.

Each Sponsor is authorised to promote its sponsorship of the Concrete Industry Awards in any way that it sees fit, providing that it respects the image of the Forum, its Organisers, Attendees and Sponsors.

It is understood that in all circumstances the Organiser retains complete responsibility for the programme, content and management of the *Concrete Construction Awards*.

TERMINATION

If the sponsor becomes bankrupt, makes any composition with his/her creditors, goes into liquidation or has a receiver appointed, fails to make payment on

the due date or breaches any of these *Terms and Conditions*, the Organiser may cancel any allocation of space/sponsorship without being under any liability to refund or rebate any charges paid or due hereunder.

In the event of the sponsor withdrawing their interest after paying the deposit, the deposit is not refundable. If the Sponsor withdraws their interest within one month of the event, the entire total agreed sponsorship is payable.

LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

The Organiser, its employees and agents shall have no liability whatsoever for

any loss, damage injury costs charges or expenses suffered or incurred by the sponsor, its employees or agents and arising whether directly or indirectly from the use or occupancy of the space or from their attendance at the awards night venue.

The Organiser reserves the right of refusal, without explanation, of any potential Sponsor.

The Organiser will not be liable for, are excused from their reasonable control, any failure to render services due to any cause beyond its reasonable control, such as a catastrophe of nature, governmental action, acts of state, third party labour difficulties or non-performance of a supplier.

HEALTH & SAFETY

The Sponsor will:

- a) Observe all health and safety rules,
- b) and regulations and other security requirements that apply at the Event and will promptly notify the Organisers as soon as it becomes aware of any health and safety hazards or issues which arise,
- c) behave at all times with reasonable care and skill and in accordance with best practices and standards and ensure adequate safety measures are in place at all times.

AWARDS VENUE

The Organiser will make every reasonable effort to adhere to the advertised

event package but reserves the right to change dates, location and content. Any communication concerning the event shall not form part of the contract. If the event is cancelled for any reason the sponsor shall receive a full refund.

COVID RESTRICTIONS

Should the in-person event be disrupted due to Covid or another pandemic it will either be run digitally or rescheduled in-person. There will be no refunds (aside from dinner tickets) or cancellations should the event be run online.
